Luna and Biel

A lunatic route across hidden valleys and small uninhabited villages in the central area of the Cinco Villas, an uncharted universe with all the ingredients for a good gravel route: landscape, solitude, medieval villages, tracks in good conditions, and roads with little traffic.

The route starts in Luna and has a long climb through a forest track and a pine forest until it reaches the summit of Sierra Mayor, passing through the Tower of Obano, and the villages of Júnez and Lacasta, which are currently being restored and repopulated. After reaching the summit, where you can enjoy the beautiful sights of the Sierra de Santo Domingo, the route follows a quiet road heading towards Fuencalderas, Biel, and Luesia. Once you pass Luesia, the route continues along a forest track towards the charming medieval villages of Asín and Orés, and then connects with a rural track in good condition that takes you back to Luna, passing by the Chapel of Yerzol and the Bardenas Canal (be careful there!) before reaching the end of the stage. Without a doubt, it is a route that will take you through one of the wildest areas in the region. If you still want more, combine it with route 4: The Steppe.
