

**TECHNICAL DATA****97,3 km****1051 m****55% Forest track****45% Road****Castejón de Valdejasa and Luna****4****THE STEPPE**

The southern area hides wonderful, solitary steppe territories. Magical spots such as the Aguarales de Valdemilaz or monuments such as the castles of Sora and Yecra.

The route, which runs mostly along local roads, starts in Luna and follows a track to Lacorvilla, passing through the Tower of Obano and the Castle of Yecra. Then, it follows the road to Valpalmas heading to Piedratajada. At km 3.5, the route diverts towards Aguareles de Valdemilaz. Warning: You have to walk across the Aguarales and carry your bike for a little while down a path, until you reach a track heading to Piedratajada.

Then, take the road to Las Pedrosas and follow a stretch of track that finishes at the beginning of the Sierra de Luna path. After this beautiful and lonely climb, the route descends to Castejón de Valdejasa and heads towards Ejea, until you reach km 38 of the A-1102 road. There, it links with a track that goes round the northern perimeter of the Castle of Sora. A lovely sight. The route continues along rural tracks until it crosses the A-125 road near the Castle of Santia and reaches the Bardenas Canal. There, another rural track in excellent conditions will take you back to Luna.
