A selection of the best gravel stretches in the Cinco Villas region.

A journey you can complete in two or three stages and start in any of the villages visited by this great loop that borders the region. A route along good and quiet tracks and roads, across the most hidden rural areas of the territory, peppered with small medieval villages and monuments where you can stop to drink, dine, and sleep.

The main characters in the southern steppe area are the Bardenas and the Aguarales. A mid-mountain, pine forest, and sandstone area that hides medieval towers and Roman sites, such as the one in Los Bañales. Hardly explored valleys, sprinkled with medieval villages that go up the side of the Sierra de Santo Domingo.

You can cross this mountain range through its Pyrenean-like boulders and forests until you reach Bal de Onsella, a magical valley hidden at the gates of the Pyrenees. Its medieval villages and monuments, as well as the Camino de Santiago, will take you to another time when you visit them with your gravel bike. In a nutshell, a surprising journey, rich in contrasts, to enjoy the solitude and treasures of this region.
