Sos del Rey Católico Peña is a ghost town in the Sierra de Peña, a mountain range at 700 m above the Sangüesa valley, which is the natural border between Aragón and Navarra.

The route climbs the mountain range and visits the ghost town and ruins of the Castle of Peña. It is a unique location, with a ton of history and beautiful panoramic views. The route starts at the hotel Parador de **Sos del Rey Católico** and, after an urban stretch, takes a descent toward the wind farm in **Peña Roya**. From the top of the wind farm, the route continues toward Sofuentes through Val de Oscura. In Sofuentes, you will have a chance to recover your strength and have something to eat before the climb toward **the ghost town of Peña** (we recommend taking a detour to visit the town) passing by the cemetery, where, oddly enough, there is the tombstone of an English plane pilot shot down by the Nazis during World War 2. After the cemetery, the route descends toward the town of **Torre de Peña**.

From the bottom of the valley, the route follows the path known as Camino de Sos del Rey Católico until it reaches road A-127. Then, it climbs until it reaches a horseshoe curve and follows a track that will take you back to the start of the route.
