## THE MILENIAL PINE OF SORA

Ejea de los Caballeros A perfect route for mountain bike beginners which starts at the bull ring of Ejea de los Caballeros and visits two points of interest: the castle of Sora and the Pine Tree of Sora. Then, the route follows the left bank of the Laverné reservoir to ascend progressively and smoothly toward the castle of Sora. This route offers a lovely view of the ruins of the castle of Sora, above sandstone cliffs, which is worth taking both a break and a picture.

Then, the route heads southeast to visit the next point of interest: the breathtaking millennial pine tree, the Borao Pine Tree, or the Pine Tree of Sora, protected by a wooden fence and listed as **singular tree in 2005**. From the pine tree, the route heads northeast, returning to Ejea de los Caballeros through irrigation areas across rural tracks in very good conditions.

Once you pass a small reservoir, you will continue toward the **Boalares pine forest**. After going through the forest, the route heads again toward Ejea de los Caballeros following the opposite direction, until you reach the bull ring where the route started.
