LOS BAÑALES



A route for those who love the spiciest marathon rallies, which takes place entirely on tracks and ventures into the montane landscapes at the centre of the region, characterised by hidden sandstone valleys with scrublands and crop fields.

This is a physically demanding route that visits points of interest such as the **Roman site of Los Bañales** and the Fuente del Diablo, and crosses several villages in this part of the region.

The route starts in Ejea de los Caballeros, climbing north toward Farasdués and venturing into the Sierra de la Marcuera range. From Farasdués, it continues climbing toward the Enforcau peak and descends toward Malpica de Arba, passing through the **Fuente del Diablo**, where you can stop to drink. From Malica, the route turns west along rural tracks toward the site of Los Bañales, which is characterised by a row of stone pillars. After visiting the site, the route heads south toward the village of Biota and then continues toward another point of interest in the area, the Bolaso reservoir. Then the route heads south, leaving the reservoir behind, toward Ejea de los Caballeros.
